

VIEWS AND DEEDS;

PROSTHETICS AND ORTHOTICS SERVICES IN STABLE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

(1) As Prostheses and Orthoses are important in the rehabilitation of a person with disabilities, together with specialized interventions, namely;

- Manufacturing, fitting of prosthetics & orthotics and;
- Physiotherapy preparing individual for fitting, helping in gait training and;
- Medical doctors specialized in rehabilitation, by assessing patients-giving prescriptions'.

In stable developing countries, an attempt to avoid the route course is tantamount to stage management denial. Co-ordination of prosthetics and orthotics programs are done by non Prosthetist & Orthotist at any managerial level. Which ultimately lead to the services not meeting people with disabilities so that they can access services of prosthetics & orthotics.

(2) Prosthetics and orthotics centers need to promote themselves actively so that the service users know about their existence. Co-ordination done by none prosthetist & orthotist limit the accessibility of patients to this services due to lack of the rationally and standard operation procedures. Fair is in large towards patients, service provider (prosthetist & orthotist) and companies which sells materials, components and so on. Request for finances on material are raising more question because the person or body that advocate for all this are not prosthetist and orthotist. Which block the break through from all perspective of business.

(3) Even though protection of technology is preserved, it is good to protect the interest of prosthetics & orthotics profession. Technology refers to the scientific knowledge used in an industry based on the point that it has been proven, e.g. making a machine. On the other side, science refers to the scientific knowledge of a structure behavior on physical world and based on an experiment. The so called co-operate world and politicians lack theory and would like to operate beyond their scope for their own financial benefit. They do so with intend by hiring prosthetist & orthotist outside their respective countries, whom do not know cultures of people from rural communities. Do not know their level of operation they are in and only would like to impress the employer. Prosthetist & Orthotist such that do so due to salaries that start appearing not supportive at any existing level.

(4) Prosthetics & orthotics programs as should work in close collaborations with other organization like ministries of health and other medical services, should also consider international NGO's at this stage. Not only at a financial stage. More governments on stable developing countries second hand over to NGO's the manpower that cross systems of NGO's. Lately lead governments proposing to take over because they have theories, without thinking of

how much an impact can come out. Achievement to take over if are done, in a very short time, all that was running accordingly would revise with multiple impact on the profession as well companies which are selling materials. Close contacts or collaboration are more important at an early stage in person.
